Summary of Investigation, Officer's Opinion, Background to case, etc.
 I talked to Mr. Franks, the reportee in this case, he showed me where the abandoned vehicle was. I saw where it appeared as though someone had vandalized the vehicle by using a heavy instrument such as a club or a pipe to break the right side window out, the right side mirror, the left side mirror and also to crack the front windshield. Whoever had damaged the car had also opened the left door of the car and slashed the front seat as well as the ransacked the contents of the front seat and the glove box as well as ransacked the contents of the trunk. When I arrived on the scene I saw that the car keys were left in the trunk lock and the trunk was open. The contents of the trunk had been ransacked although it was impossible for me to tell if anything was missing. I asked Mr. Franks if he knew whose car this was and he told me he did not however told me that his son had not returned home since last night and the reason that Mr. Franks found the car was because he was out in Midway Park looking for his son. Mr. Franks told that he did not recognize this car as belonging to his son or his son's friends and otherwise.

had no idea who the car belonged too. At this time Special Investigator Kirk arrived and took several pictures to show the condition and the location of the silver car. Officer Kirk will make a Form 3 to further detail his photographs.

I saw that the license plate number of the car was 1982 Texas MNT981 and at this time submitted 10-28 on the license plate through the computer. The computer return showed that the car belonged to Clifford Oliver of 3704 Hay, Waco, Texas. The dispatcher attempted to call Mr. Oliver however was unsuccessful. While searching inside the car I found Clifford Oliver's address and also the phone number 752-3792. The dispatcher called this number and talked to Barbara Oliver and Ms. Oliver said that she and her husband had had a fight last night and she did not know where the car was although her husband Clifford was driving it. Ms. Oliver said that she did not know if the car was damaged and did not know where her husband had taken the car. She attempted to call her husband however was unsuccessful. At this time I had the dispatcher contact James Wrecker Service and I impounded the car and completed a impound inventory card in reference to this case. The car was towed to 1800-B LaSalle and stored by James Wrecker Service and the keys were left in the car at James Wrecker Service. It is my opinion that although Mr. Oliver may have driven the car out to Midway Park someone else probably vandalized the car while Mr. Oliver might have been gone with some of his friends. I was unable to obtain any further information from Mrs. Oliver about the whereabouts of Mr. Oliver to confirm this information. I searched the area around the car to see if perhaps Mr. Oliver was sleeping in the area or if he had been injured and might be laying in the area however I did not locate Mr. Oliver or anyone else around the scene of this vehicle. At this time I will show this case to be an abandoned vehicle however if any further information is obtained possible charges of criminal mischief or burglary of a motor vehicle may be filed in reference to this case.
