At 12:20P, 7-16-82, I received information from J.P. JOE JOHNSON concerning further results the autopsies of the three victims in this case.

The autopsy revealed that the weapon used was a knife with an approximate length of five in the blade one-half inch in width, the blade thickness approximately one-sixteenth of an inch and the knife blade was single edged.

Neither of the white females was pregnant.

The pathologists in Dallas estimate that the time of death was between 9:P and 12 midnight 7-13-82.

The great vessels in the necks of all three victims had not been severed.

The pathologists were not able to determine if the wounds to the victims were inflicted while the victims while the victims were standing or lying. However, all the wounds on the MONTGOMERY girl and the FRANKS boy were vertical.

Some of the wounds to the RICE girl were not exactly vertical but varied between 10 and 15 degrees up and down.

All the knots used to bind the victims were tied with granny knots.

There were no bruises on any of the victims.

The official cause of the death to all three victims were knife wounds to the heart.
